Titan 2023-2024 Registration

Our 2023-2024 season registration will open for existing Titan swimmers on Wednesday, August 9th. We will send an email to all current membership prior to August 9th with specific information, action items, our updated 2023-2024 Handbook, and instructions to complete should you decided not to re-join our team next season.

A couple important reminders prior to re-registering for the team:

- 1. Swimmers will be registered for their current level unless you receive communication from Titan coaches prior to 8/9/23 advising otherwise.
- 2. Our club is a year-round commitment. When you register for our team, you are committing to being a member from September 2023 (or the day of your registration) until August 2024. Although we do not have defined practice or meet entry requirements, this commitment does include all Safe Sport, financial, and volunteering assignments through the end of the season.
- Current USA Swimming registrations are valid through the end of 2023. We will communicate with you in November 2023 with instructions on how to renew for 2024.
- 4. Family Participation Requirements (Volunteer Hours) will be assigned to each account based on your swimmer(s) level(s) and the number of family members on our team. Families that have swimmer(s) in Level 1 Level 8 will be assigned obligations which must be fulfilled by the end of the 2023-2024 season to avoid a per session mandatory fee to your account.
- 5. The Town of Tonawanda requires that all swimmers on our club obtain either a Titan Practice Pass OR a Tonawanda Aquatic Fitness Center membership. The cost of the Titan Practice Pass is \$125 and will be due upon registration unless your swimmer(s) have an active AFC Membership. Level 7/8 swimmers must purchase the AFC Membership to participate in weight room sessions.

*The only exception to this is our Stroke Development program which will offer three sessions in 2023-2024: Session 1: Sept – Dec, Session 2: Jan – April, Session 3: May – August. Additional information about this program will be sent to our current Stroke Development swimmers in a separate email.
